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REUNION SCHEDULE

Tuesday 8th

Complimentary hot deluxe breakfast, buffet style is available in the Breakfast Room from 7 to 10 AM. (Guests will be given Breakfast Vouchers when they check in – up to 2 per room, per day they're staying.)

Sign in and welcoming from 10-11 AM in the Crystal Ballroom. This is a great time to renew old friendships and to meet new friends. The Crystal Ballroom will serve as our hospitality room and banquet room for the duration of the reunion. We will have patches, pins, and decals for purchase at the registration table.

Branson Belle Showboat: Please be ready to board at least 1 hour prior to 12:30 PM the cruise time. The address is 4800 Historic Hwy 165, Branson, Mo. (See map, 7.5 miles, 13 min. drive) Seating arrangements are assigned on the day of the cruise and tickets will be available for pick-up from **Hank and Bob** (1) hour prior to the scheduled cruise time near the box office.

Note: Transportation to this event will be by POV and will rely on car-pooling. If you have additional space, please inform a member of the reunion staff at registration and they will match you up with those that need it.

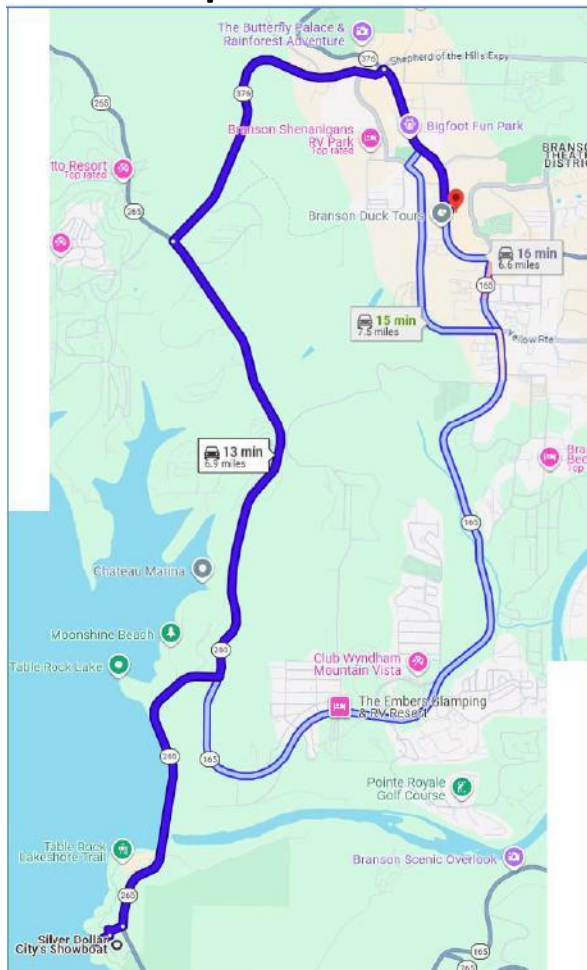
